Choose Wisely

Choose a poinsettia without yellow leaves at the bottom and tight buttons in the center.

STEP

01

Careful Transpo

Use care not to expose your plant to chilly temperatures. Even though they bloom in Christmas, cold temps will freeze and kill your plant.

Unpack with Intention

Gently unsleeve by tearing from the bottom up, slowly, so as not to break the branches.







STEP 04

Temperature is Key

Place in indirect sunlight at about 65 degrees Fahrenheit.
Do not place your plant near a

Hydration Station

Keep the plant consistently moist without wilting; do not let it sit in water.
